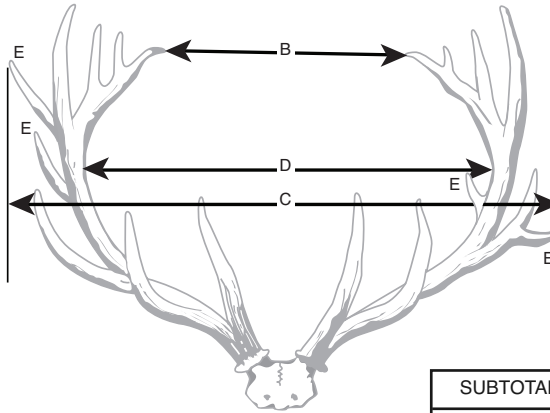
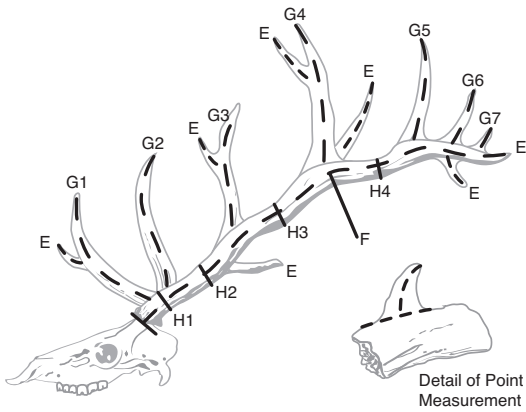

Wisconsin Buck & Bear Club Fair Chase Affidavit

Please Read and Sign

Entry into the WBBC Records Program is based on the following criteria:

- All animals are measured using the Boone & Crockett Scoring System.
- The animals must meet the minimum WBBC scoring requirement for that specie.
- The animal must have been taken in an ethical manner and in complete compliance of State of Wisconsin game laws or regulations, or Tribal game laws or regulations if harvested under Tribal Jurisdiction.
- Animals harvested under the following circumstances do not meet Fair Chase criteria
 1. By the use of any power vehicles such as atv's, utv's, snowmobiles or boats.
 2. Any animals taken from a game farm or from an escape proof enclosure.
 3. By the use of any weapon that is not recognized by the State of Wisconsin for use in harvesting that animal.
 4. Harvesting a helpless animal in water, deep snow, on ice, or having locked antlers with another animal.
 5. Any other condition considered by the Records Committee to be unacceptable or unethical.

Falsification of the Fair Chase Affidavit is grounds for dismissal from The Wisconsin Buck & Bear Club. Falsification of this Affidavit or conviction of a game violation will cause the entry to be rejected, no further entries accepted and all past entries to be removed from the Records Program. In addition to the requirements of this Affidavit, by submitting this entry the applicant agrees that the sole decision of acceptance of this entry belongs to the Board of Directors and its discretionary decision is final.

All photographs submitted with an entry become property of the WBBC and can be used by the WBBC or its partners in any form on social media, magazines or record books. All scoring decisions made by Pope & Young or Boone & Crockett will become final and scores will be adjusted to reflect that change in our Records Program.
